During the 2016-2017 academic year, the Committee also considered 3 (three) cases for rank and tenure associated with new hires. All members participated in all deliberations, except for two Associate Professors who could not vote on promotion to Professor and one Professor that abstained due to voting on a case at the department level. To date, the committee has considered 1 (one) person for appointment at Full Professor with Tenure and 2 (two) people for appointment at Associate Professor with Tenure.
