# UNDERGRADUATE CURRICULUM PROPOSAL MUSIC EDUCATION DEPARMENT

The Music Education Department proposes modifications in B.M.E. curricula for each of the general, choral, and instrumental music programs. The proposal reflects recent developments within the field of music education and is based on extensive discussion, input from music teachers in the field, feedback from former students, and forthcoming changes in Indiana certification requirements. Changes in certification will emphasize demonstration of competencies by developmental level (e.g., early childhood, K-3, intermediate, secondary). Accordingly, the proposed curricula will lead to certification at multiple developmental levels within each of the specializations of choral, general, and instrumental music.

The proposed curricula maintain current requirements in general education, ensemble, music performance, and core music courses in theory and history. The proposed changes occur within music education and professional education requirements.

Some aspects of the proposal affect each of the general, choral, and instrumental areas while others are specific to each program. As necessitated by changes in state requirements, each program features greater specialization within music education than is presently the case. Likewise, each program places more emphasis on active rather than passive field experiences, with structured field experiences beginning in the freshman year and culminating in a full semester of student teaching. The proposed full semester of teaching experience is a significant increase beyond the current 10-week experience. These changes reflect important input from music teachers in the field.

Another commonality across the general, choral, and instrumental programs will be freshman and senior seminars (see attached course descriptions). The proposed freshman colloquium replaces the current course, E131 Introduction to Music Education, and the additional course, E490 Senior Seminar in Music Education, will serve as a capstone seminar that follows student teaching. It will focus on the preparation for professional life and the further development of reflective and critical thinking skills. Likewise the addition of I101 Music Education Master Class (0 credits) will provide a structured means for discussion of current professional issues and a context in which to present guest lectures, clinics, and workshops for undergraduate students. I102 Music Education Master Class in Student Teaching will be offered for students concurrently with their student teaching semester and will replace the former EdM 471 seminar.

Proficiency in technology is mandated by the environment in which our students will teach. This proficiency will be demonstrated by all B.M.E. students during the upper divisional examination at the conclusion of the sophomore year. The upper divisional examination will be extended beyond the current evaluation in the major performance area and interview in music education to include assessment of students' portfolios.

### B.M.E. -- Instrumental Program

The following summarizes modifications that are specific to the instrumental music program:

- The new course, E230 Music Education Instrumental Laboratory (1 cr.) (see attached description), will be a co-requisite for F281 Brass Techniques (2 cr.) and F337 Woodwind Techniques (2 cr.). E230 is added because of new certification requirements and the department's view that students need greater experience in a beginning level mixed instrument setting.
- Previously, instrumental students enrolled in either F466 Marching Band Techniques (1-2 cr.) or E458 Pedagogy of Jazz (2 cr.). Both courses will be required in the proposed curriculum because competency in both areas is required for teachers in today's schools.
- The new course, E420 String Pedagogy (2 cr.) (see attached description), will provide greater specialization within the major field for string education majors. This course parallels the specialization in marching band and jazz pedagogy required of wind and percussion players.

instruction, the introduction and development of vibrato, the development of the bow arm, and fostering awareness of intonation and tuning are other important areas that will be addressed. Practical considerations such as minor repair and maintenance and solo, chamber, string orchestra, and full symphony orchestra repertoire will also be included. This course is required for all instrumental music education majors with a concentration in strings.

E458 Pedagogy of Jazz (2 cr.): Techniques and methods of teaching jazz studies, including the training of jazz bands.

E459 Instrumental Pedagogy (3 cr.): Pedagogy classes pertaining to individual instruments.

E490 Senior Seminar in Music Education (3 cr.): Co-requisite, EdM482 Student Teaching (16 cr.). This capstone seminar focuses on issues concerning the music education profession: its history, contemporary ideas, rationales for school music, professional organizations, and the teacher's professional responsibilities. Drawing on a semester's experience in student teaching in music, the student will synthesize what has been learned in preceding courses, teaching observations, and experience. The students produce artifacts for their professional portfolios including web pages, video-taped teaching excerpts, a research paper on the history of the music education profession, a synthesis paper on readings about contemporary music education thought and rationales for music education in the schools, a general curricular plan for their particular specialties, a reflective paper constituting personal statements of belief about music education, and a preliminary plan for personal growth as a teacher.

E494 Voice Pedagogy (3 cr.): Principles of voice production--quality, diction, range, breathing, vocalization, dynamics, agility, and vocal hygiene--as bases for an approach to voice teaching.

F205 Introduction to Instrumental Techniques (2 cr.): For B.M.E. voice and piano concentrations. Techniques and materials for beginning instrumental study.

F281 Brass Instrument Techniques (2 cr.): Class instruction and teaching methods for trumpet, horn, trombone, and tuba.

F302 Classroom Instrument Techniques (2 cr.): Beginning instruction in recorder, guitar, barred percussion (Orff instruments), dulcimer, autoharp, and small percussion appropriate for use in classroom general music instruction. Required of music education general majors; open to others with permission of instructor.

F337 Woodwind Techniques (2 cr.): Class instruction and teaching methods for flute, oboe, bassoon, clarinet, and saxophone.

I102 Master Class in Music Education-Student Teaching Section (0 cr.): Corequisite, EdM482 Student Teaching (16 cr.). The purpose of this master class is to prepare and support music education students for their student teaching experience. Topics will include suggestions for a successful student teaching experience, classroom management techniques, preparation of lesson plans, and responsibilities during student teaching. Students will complete a field project and portfolio as a part of the class; there will be three meetings during the student teaching semester.

#### School of Education Courses

EdM342 Methods and Materials for Teaching Elementary Music (3 cr.): Prerequisite, admission to the Teacher Education Program, E131 Freshmen Colloquium in Music Education, and E231 General Music Methods for Grades 7-12. Co-requisite, EdM301 Laboratory/Field Experience (0 cr.). Teaching methods and materials, organization of the elementary general music curriculum.

EdM343 Methods and Materials for Teaching Choral Music (3 cr.): Prerequisite, junior standing, admission to the Teacher Education Program, E131 Freshmen Colloquium in Music Education, and E231 General Music Methods for Grades 7-12. Corequisite, EdM301 Laboratory/Field Experience (0 cr.). Teaching methods and materials, organization of the choral curriculum.

EdM344 Methods and Materials for Teaching Instrumental Music (2-3 cr.): Prerequisite, junior standing, admission to the Teacher Education Program, E131 Freshmen Colloquium in Music Education, and E231 General Music Methods for Grades 7-12. Co-requisite, EdM301 Laboratory/Field Experience (0 cr.). Teaching methods and materials; organization of the instrumental curriculum.

EdM434 Administration of School Bands (2 cr.): Prerequisite, senior standing, EdM344 Methods and Materials for Teaching Instrumental Music. Teaching, organization, and administration of school wind and percussion ensembles.

EdM436 Administration of School Orchestras (2 cr.): Prerequisite, senior standing, EdM344 Methods and Materials for Teaching Instrumental Music. Teaching, organization, and administration of school orchestras.

EdM482 Student Teaching: All Grades (16 cr.): Prerequisite, senior standing, upperdivision hearing, 10 credit hours of instrumental techniques (where required); all required conducting, education, and music education courses with the exception of Education M464 Methods of Teaching Reading. Co-requisite, I102 Music Education Master Class in Student Teaching (0 cr.). A sixteen-week, full-time, continuous, and supervised teaching experience.
